



Ambassador Volunteer

Brown Bagging for Calgary's Kids (BB4CK) works to connect and inspire people to take meaningful action to feed and care for kids. Each school day we provide healthy lunches to hungry kids, and we empower communities to create lasting social change.

Impact: Ambassador volunteers help to increase BB4CK's visibility in the community through engagement with attendees at events, which in turn helps us to increase our community of donors and volunteers!

Role: We are looking for individuals who can commit to a minimum of 1 event per month. Hours and location will vary by event. Volunteers will represent BB4CK at fairs, markets and events. You will be introducing people to BB4CK, answering questions, taking donations, and taking part in other duties that will vary by event. Volunteers are required to take training (provided by BB4CK) before engaging in this role. Preference will be given to volunteers already engaged with BB4CK.

Responsibilities:

- Knowledgeable about BB4CK, with the ability to answer basic questions, share stories and connect for further information if needed.
- Ability to set up for an event, including setting up banners and creating a display of BB4CK information and swag on a table.
- Able to pick up and return event materials and attend events via own means of transportation.
- Light to moderate lifting and bending is required.

Qualifications: Ambassador volunteers will have an outgoing personality, excellent communication skills, be able to lift up to 20lbs, and have a reliable mode of transportation.
