



Delivery Driver Volunteer

Brown Bagging for Calgary's Kids (BB4CK) works to connect and inspire people to take meaningful action to feed and care for kids. Each school day we provide healthy lunches to hungry kids, and we empower communities to create lasting social change.

Impact: Delivery Driver Volunteers are fundamental to our downtown kitchen operations – this role ensures that the lunches made in our kitchen are delivered on-time to the schools needing them. Delivery Drivers ensure that there are no hungry kids on the day they are delivering!

Role: This position is available Monday – Thursday mornings. There are 3 shift start times on Monday and Wednesdays: 9:15am, 9:30am and 9:45am. Tuesday and Thursday drivers arrive at 9:30am. All shifts end by 12:00pm. This position requires a commitment of 2 shifts per month. The location is our downtown kitchen – 433 MacLeod Trail SE.

Responsibilities:

- Driving a route given to you when you arrive at the kitchen; helping to pack your bins in your vehicle while at the kitchen; delivering the bins to the schools that are on your route list; bringing back the leftover bins and icepacks from the previous day from the schools that you deliver to; and dropping your ice packs, bins and key fob back at the kitchen after you are done delivering.
- Volunteers must have their own vehicle and are responsible to ensure that they have a valid driver's license and insurance. Please let your insurance company know you are volunteering with your own vehicle.
- All duties must be performed following general health and safety guidelines as instructed.
- Moderate lifting and bending are required.

Qualifications: Delivery Driver Volunteers will have their own vehicle, be licensed and insured, have good navigation and communication skills, and be able to lift up to 50lbs.
