## **Delivery Floater Volunteer**

Brown Bagging for Calgary's Kids (BB4CK) works to connect and inspire people to take meaningful action to feed and care for kids. Each school day we provide healthy lunches to hungry kids, and we empower communities to create lasting social change.

**Impact:** Getting lunches made and out the door to delivery volunteers by 9:30am is no easy feat; the Delivery Floater helps to ensure the process of getting lunches from the kitchen, to drivers, and into schools, goes smoothly.

**Role:** This position is from 8:00am-10:00am, Monday to Thursday. Training is conducted on-site; no prior training is required. The location is our downtown kitchen – 433 MacLeod Trail SE.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Volunteers will distribute key fobs and delivery routes; help guide drivers in and out of the parkade; distribute lunch bins to the drivers; help load and unload bins; and fill in for a delivery if needed.
- Light to moderate lifting and bending is required. You will also be required to stand the whole time.

**Qualifications:** Delivery Floater Volunteers will be flexible, organized, have a strong eye for detail, and be able to lift up to 50 lbs.
