

Why is the grocery card program ending?

This program began as an emergency response to the COVID-19 school closures and was extended until the end of the 2019-2020 school year. Pausing the grocery card program for the summer months will allow our team to:

1. Assess and plan for how the BB4CK Community can best care for kids in our city's changing climate
2. Continue to partner with communities through Food Finder YYC
